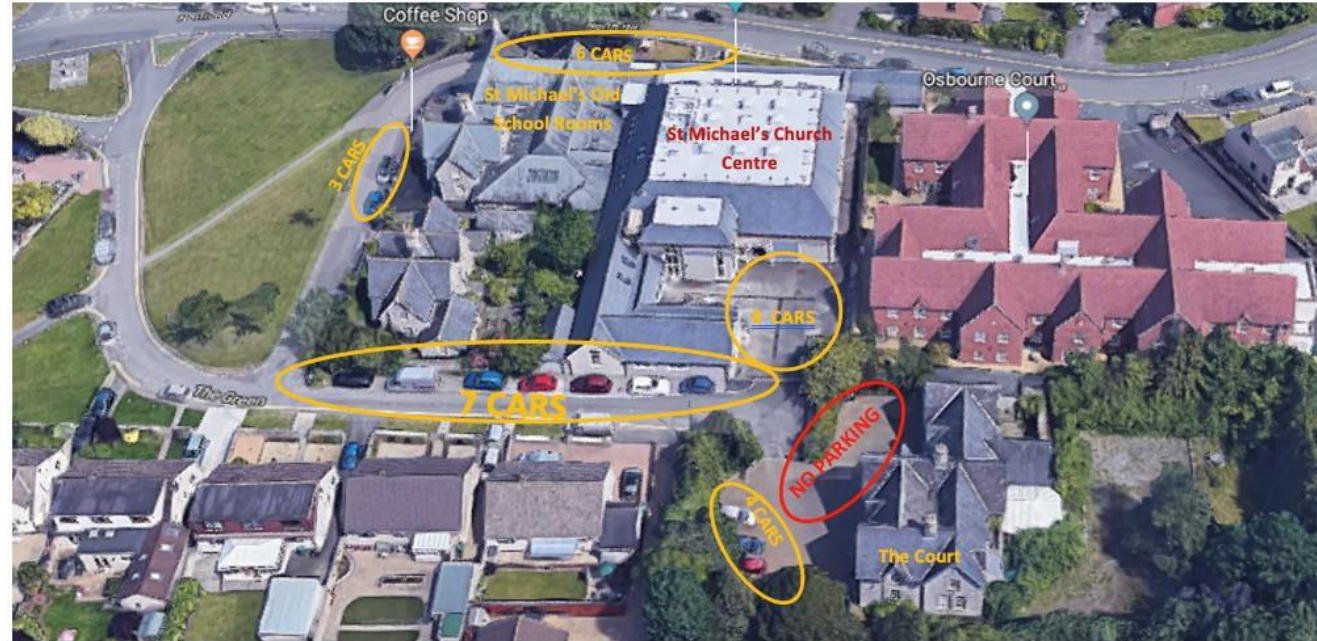


## Free Parking at St Michael's Centre

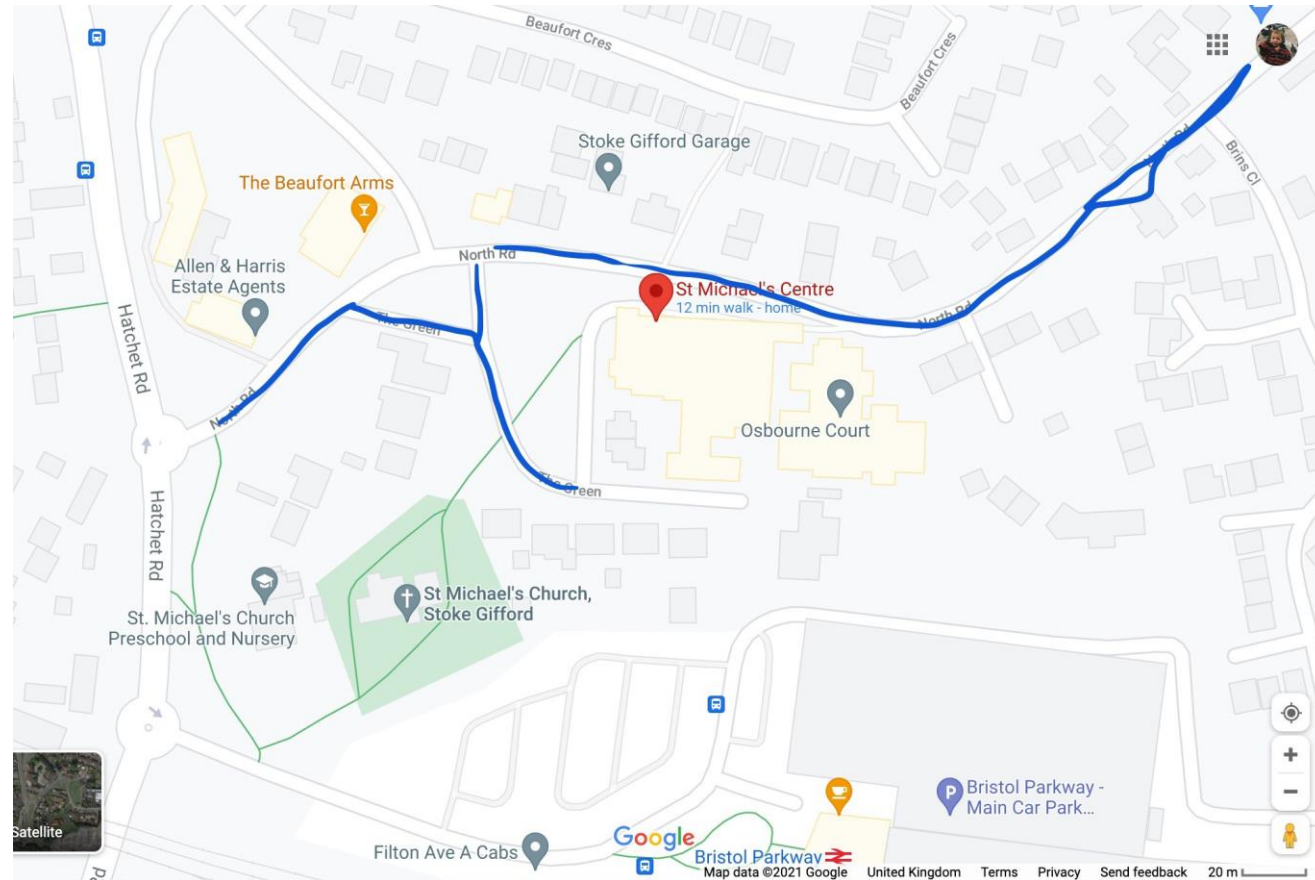


Users of the Old School Rooms and the new St Michael's Church Centre can park in five distinct areas during the week

1. 6 car spaces - directly in front of the main entrance to the Old School Rooms
2. 3 car spaces – directly outside the Coffee Shop (but do NOT park in front of the access steps)
3. 7 car spaces – on the gravel strip at the rear of the new centre
4. 8 car spaces in the rear car park through the left-hand gates
5. 4/5 car spaces in the southwest part of the Court Farmhouse (do **NOT** park in front of the left-hand offices)  
...these 4/5 over-flow spaces are available to us by the kind permission of the owners of The Court

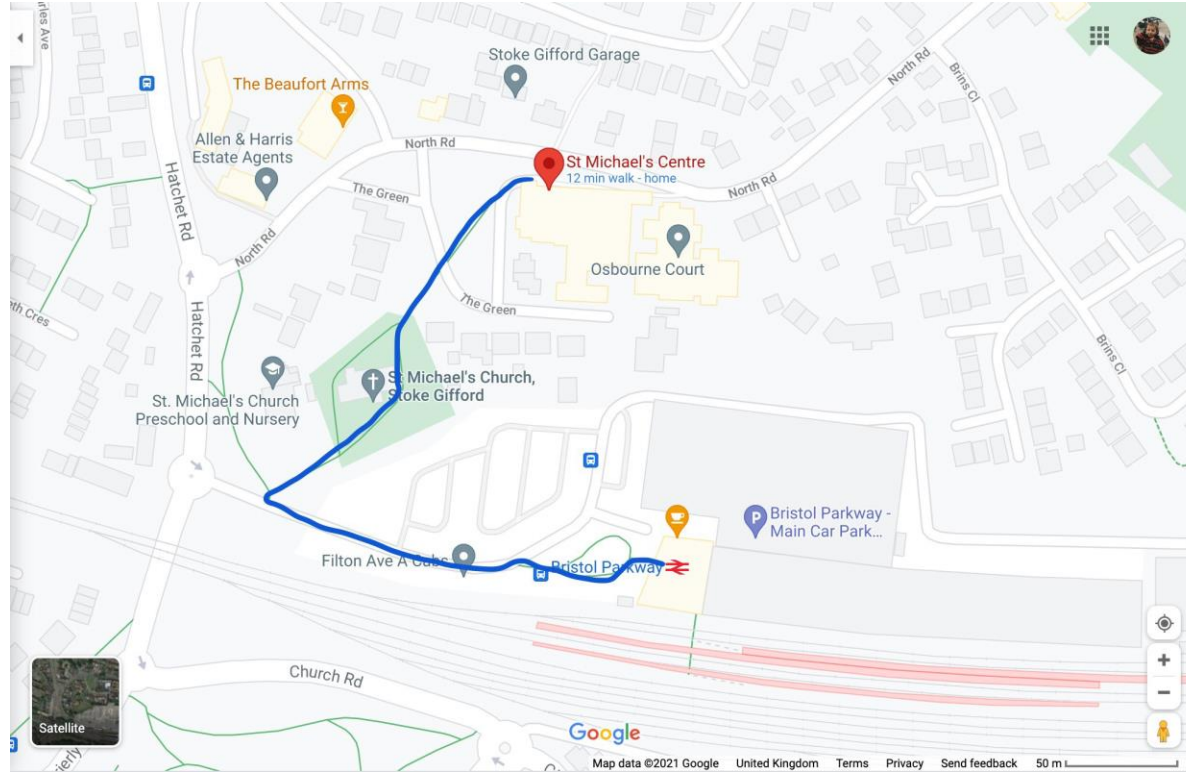
In the above image and text, you can see the parking offered at St Michael's. There is not loads of parking so in the rest of this document we are showing you other places that you can consider to park.

# On Street Parking nearby St Michael's



There is on street parking all along North Road, The Green and Hatchet Lane. However, you cannot park there between 1:00pm and 1:30pm on weekdays only. But from after 1:30pm, anybody can park there. However, these spots cannot be reserved as they are accessible to the public and as there is a pub & a train station, people might take up the spaces.

## Bristol Parkway Station – St Michael's Centre

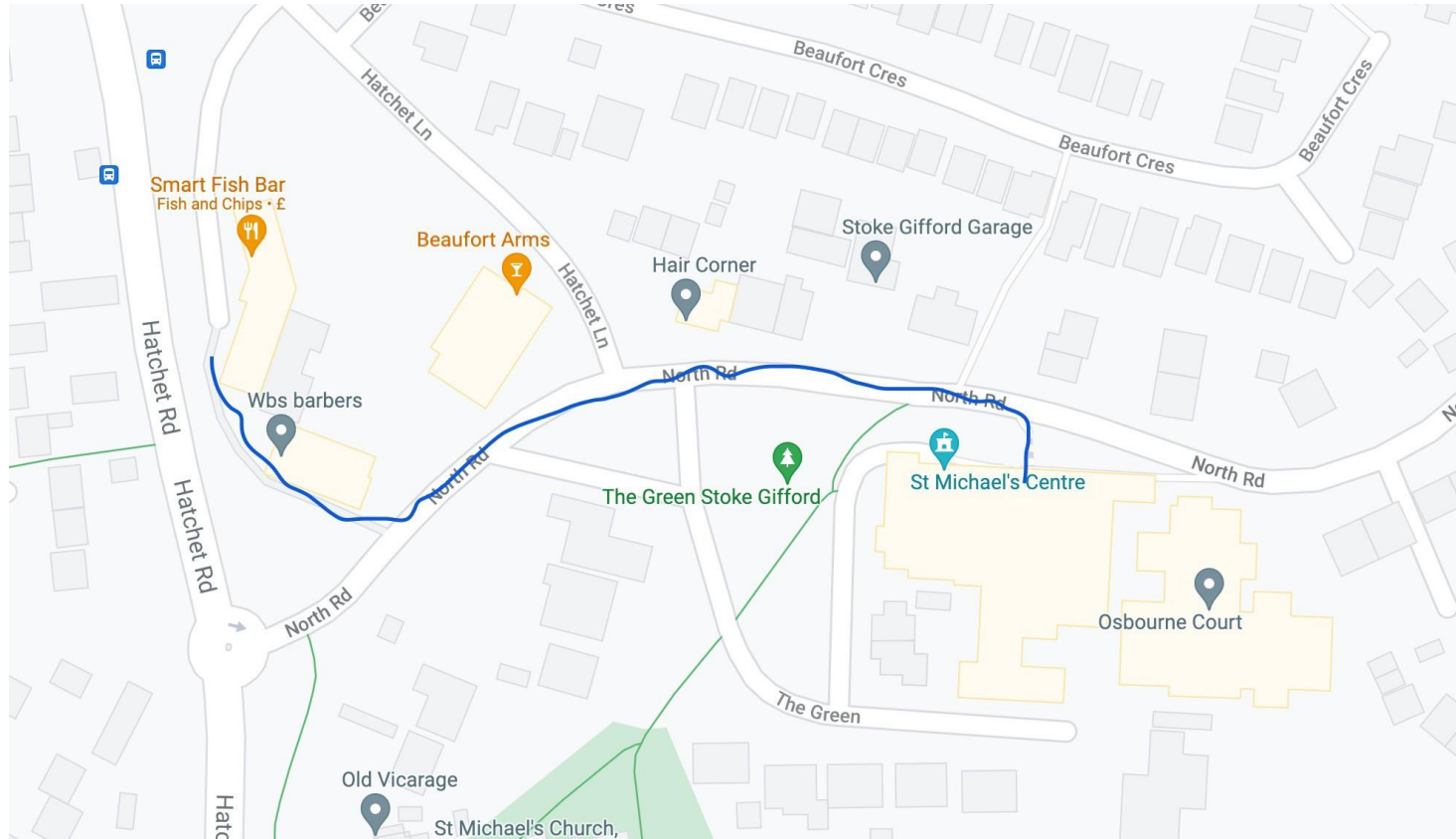


St Michael's is located perfectly within a 5-minute walk from Bristol Parkway Station. Trains are regular through Bristol Parkway due to its connection to Wales.

Bristol Parkway has a multistory car park where your attendees can pay to park at a premium. The cost of the car park is £8.70 on weekdays and £5.20 on weekends

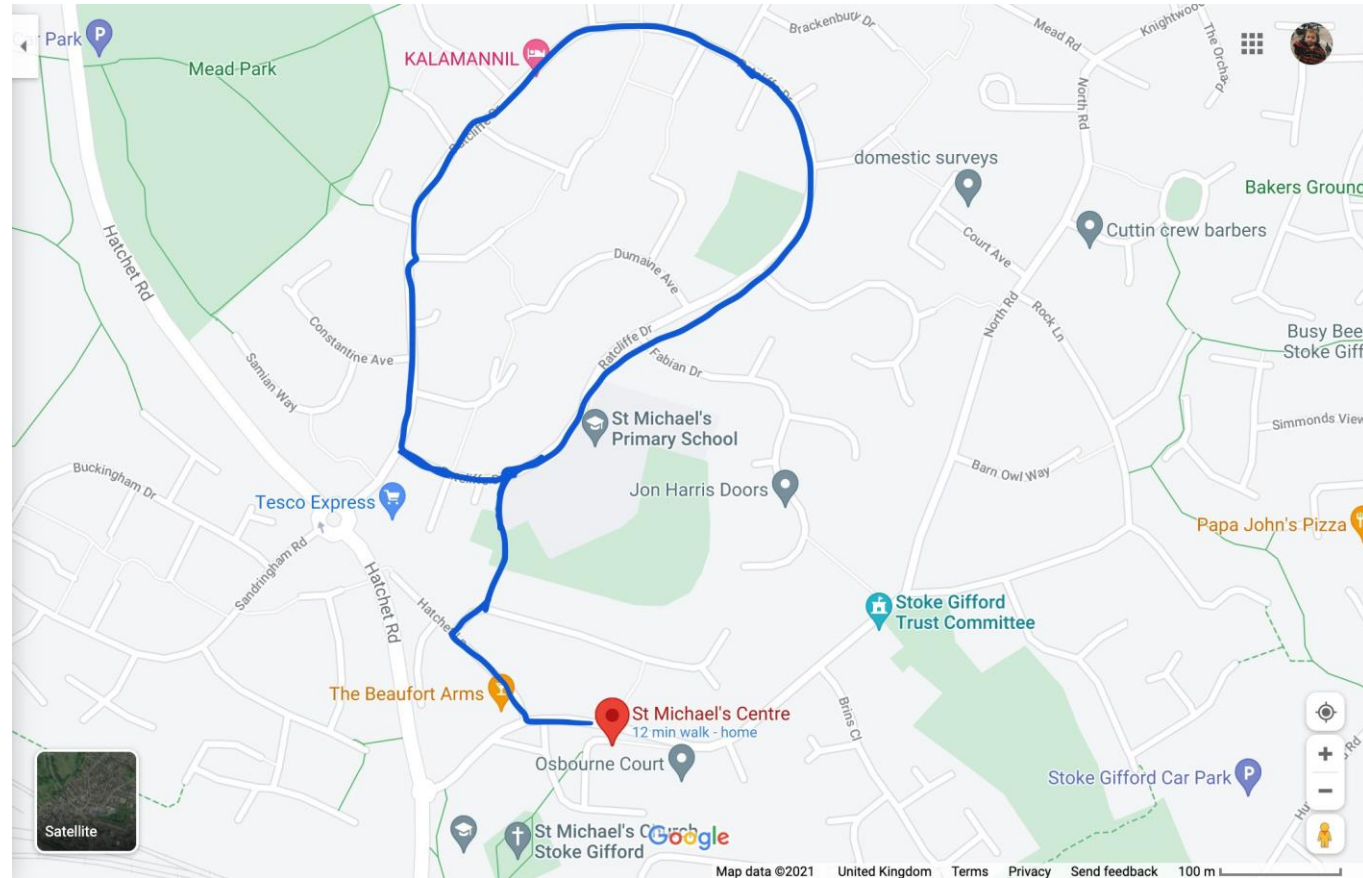
Bristol Parkway also offers a taxi rank, where taxis are often queuing up waiting for customers if you are unable to walk a distance from the train station

## The Old Pub/Co-op: St Michael's Centre



St Michael's Centre is located nearby an abandoned building which used to be a Co-op supermarket and before that was a pub. Currently, as of 2022, it has plenty of free parking for people to park in so that you can park nearby the Centre. The old Co-op is a 2-minute walk away from the Centre

## Free on-street parking



From St Michael's Centre, about 10-12 minutes away there is a big road called Ratcliffe Drive which has on street parking all around. There is no restrictions around there and it is a perfectly safe and very nice neighbourhood.
