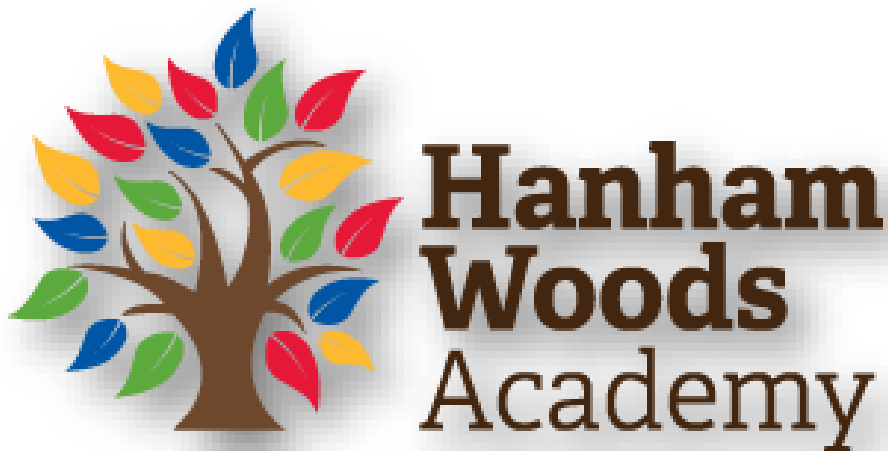


Hanham Woods Academy Summer preparation work for students going into Year 7 in 2020 / 2021
