Dear Parents/Carers

I am sure you will be following the ongoing controversy regarding Post-16 results and that you will be wondering how this will affect your child's GCSE results this coming week. Guidance will be offered to students when they collect their results next week. In terms of GCSE results collection, you should have now booked your time allocation for your child to come into the Academy to collect their results. If you cannot attend for any reason you have three options, as follows:

1. Send a stamped, self-addressed envelope to the academy and your results will be posted home
2. Come into the academy to collect your results from Tuesday 1st September
3. Get someone else to collect your results – this person will need to have a signed letter from you and photo ID

Please remember we will be following social distancing and hygiene protocols when arriving and collecting results, therefore, please do follow the instructions you are given on arrival.

We anticipate the vast majority of students will gain results they are happy with and that will enable them to progress to their chosen next steps. If this is not the case, or you have any questions, members of staff will be on hand to offer advice and guidance.
