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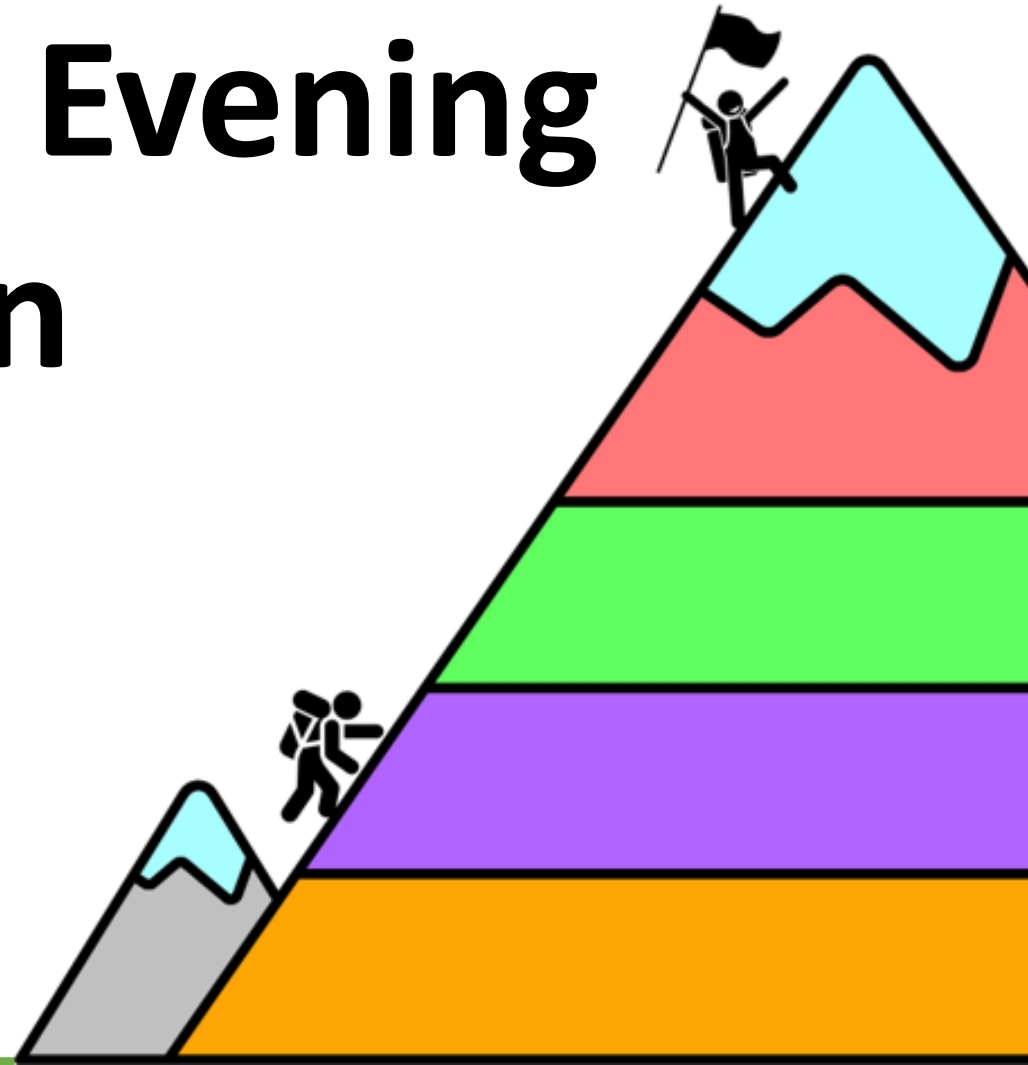

Politeness gets us where we need to go in life. We have genuine mutual respect and show gratitude. *We climb the mountain* and become the best possible version of ourselves.

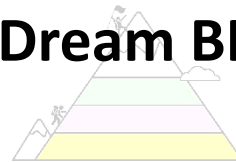

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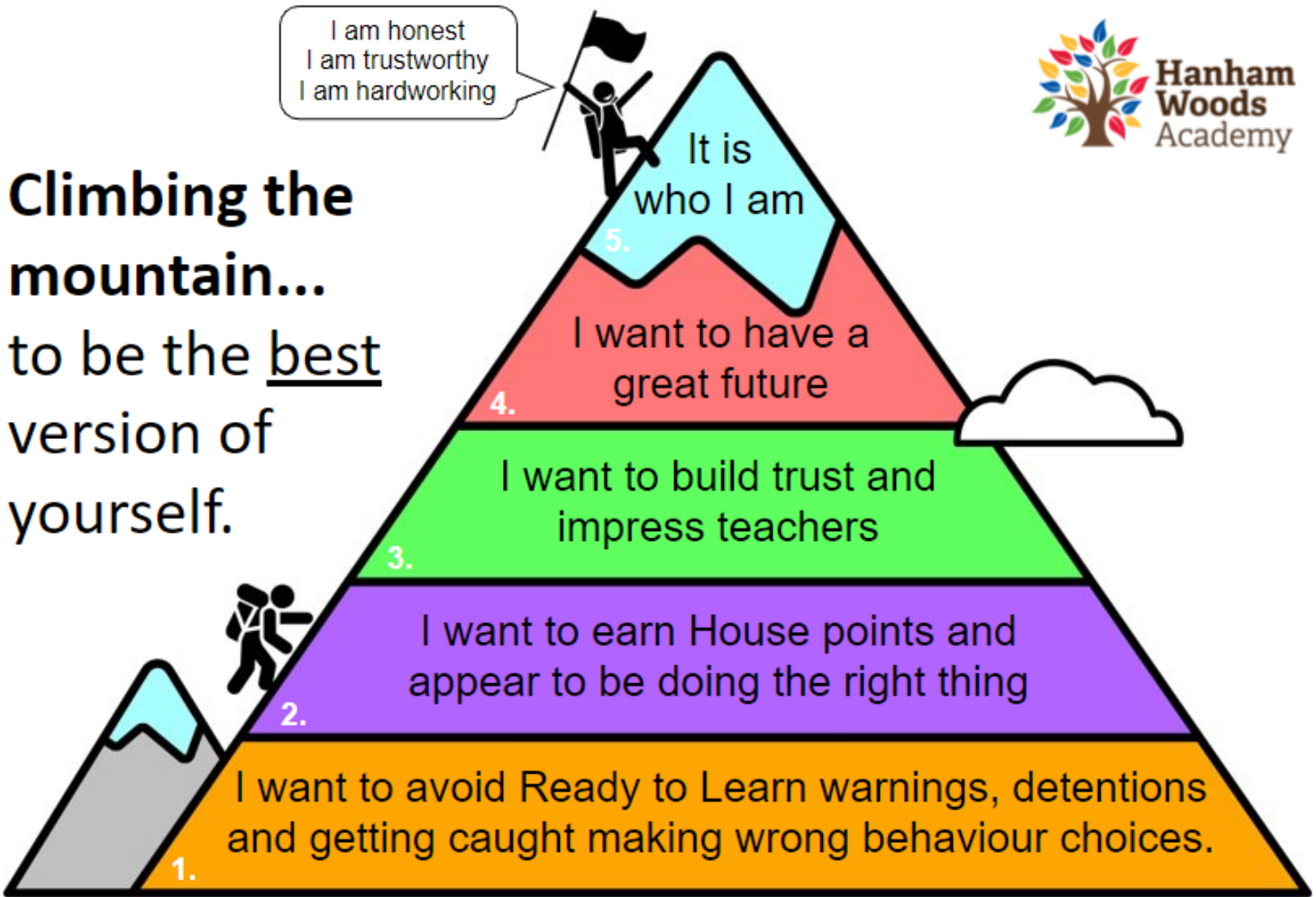
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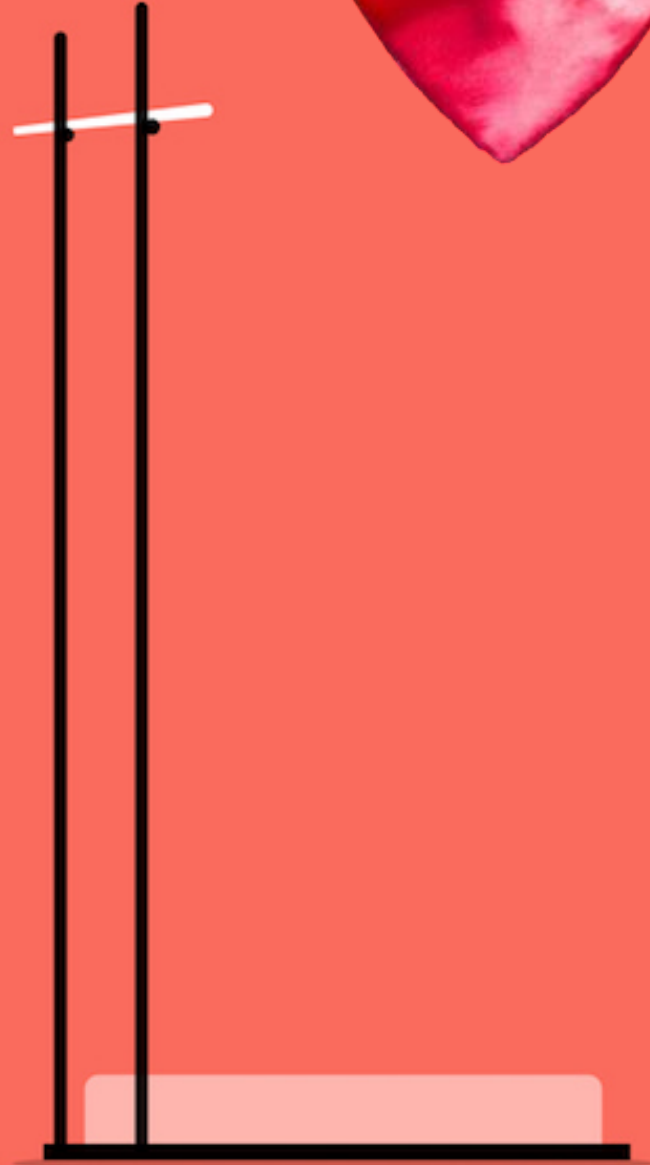

Tutor Reading

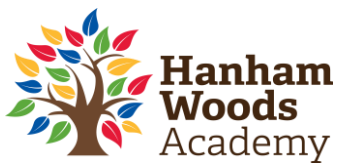
Tutors and students will read some brilliant books together

Uniform & Appearance

Student Appearance

Our uniform is a shared symbol of our values as an Academy; we want all our students to take pride in wearing their uniform.

White, long/short sleeved, button-down shirt or blouse.
No polo shirts.

A waterproof outercoat may be worn to the Academy, this should be black colour and without large branding or logo.
No non-waterproof, zip-up tops or hoodies/sweatshirts are to be worn.

Black, tailored, loose-fitting trousers.
No jeans, denim, stretchy fabric, zip pockets chinos or leggings.

Black, tailored, loose-fitting shorts may be worn in term 5 and 6.
No denim, chinos or cargo or sports shorts.

Black, grey or white, calf-high socks or black tights.
No colourful or fluffy socks.

Black, leather/leather-look shoes.
No trainers, sports brands or boots.

No extremes of make up or hair colour/style.

Simple ear and/or nose studs may be worn to the Academy but must be removed or taped for PE.
No hooped ear/nose-rings, septum bars or additional facial piercings. No large or loose fitting jewellery should be worn around the neck or wrist.

Hanham Woods embroidered, V-neck jumper that matches the House colour of the student; this must be brought to school every day.
No hoodies or sweatshirts to be worn on top of Academy uniform.

Black, tailored skirt that stays at the knee when worn.
No skirts that become see-through when stretched or that fit too close to the hip. Tight "tube style" skirts are not permitted.

Hanham Woods, House tie that matches the House colour of the student.

- Plain, black, sports-sweatshirt

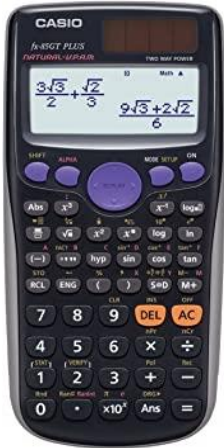

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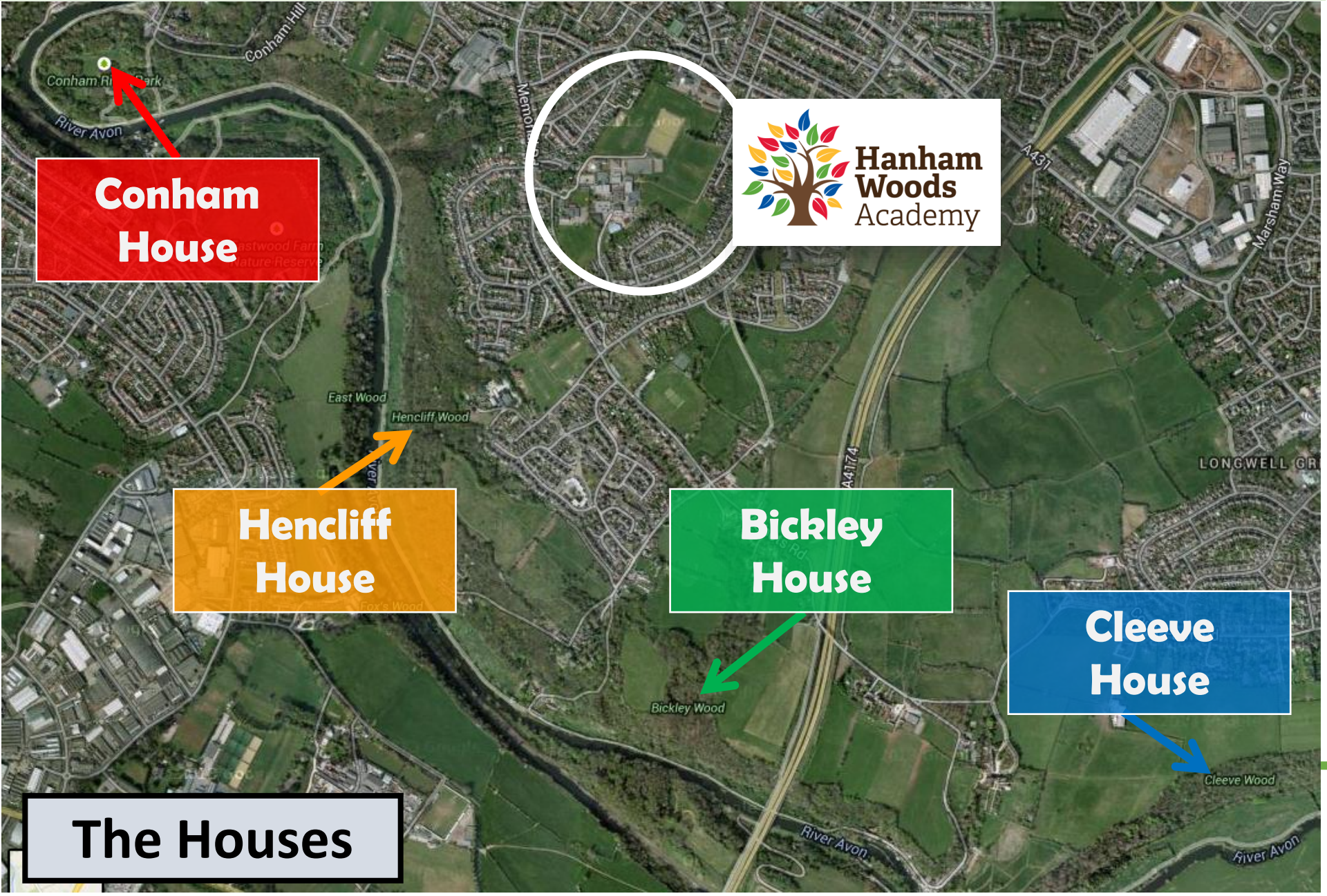
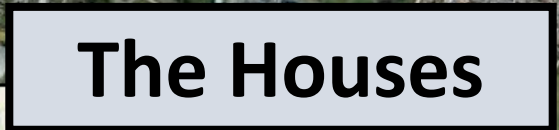
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The Academy Day

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The Question Mark area will be the base for Y7s for their first week of lessons.

Staff will collect their classes from this area before each lesson and walk them to their classrooms.



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Lunchtimes and Online systems

At Lunchtime students can either bring a packed lunch to school or they can purchase both hot and cold food from the canteen.

We operate cashless tills, so all payments are made via a fingerprint system. Their account can either be charged up via our paypoint machine or via SCOPAY, our online payment system.

For the first 2 days of school, students will need to bring a packed lunch whilst their accounts are created.



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The Big Step- Thursday July 7th 2022

- Wear comfortable, non-uniform clothing (including trainers).
- Backpack with pencil case, refillable water bottle and then suncream/hat or coat (depending on the weather).
- To arrive at school between 9.15am and 9.30am (no earlier please).
- All students will be registered and taken to the Main Hall for their Welcome Assembly.
- Packed lunch will be needed.
- Students will spend their sessions in House groups.
- Students will then be free to leave the Academy site at 2.45pm, they can either be collected or make their own way home (bike and scooter storage will be available).
